expansion of Science, Technology, Engineering, and Math

(STEM)-related programs, Research Experiences for Teachers

(RET), and the K-12 creative media education programs. The

Department recommends that STEM-related programs be

expanded to include Career and Technical Education pathways.

consider reinstating the support for K-12 STEM-related programs

in addition to the K-12 after-school creative media education

initiatives.
