Pacific Resource Partnership (PRP) is in strong support of the purpose and intent of SB1674, the amendment of Act 161, Session Laws of Hawaii 2007, to increase the bond issuance limit from \$100,000,000 to \$150,000,000 and also to extend the authority to issue bonds from the ending FY2009-2010 to ending FY2010-2011.

The additional revenue bonds and extension requests would help with critical facility repairs/needs and would help stimulate our economy by bringing much needed jobs.
