I am writing to voice my strong support of this bill and its intent to delete the 20 year maximum permit term for parasailing and commercial thrill craft commercial use and operator permits. I also support deleting the entire provision that puts a permit up for auction after this 20 year maximum permit term.

Permit holders that have met the state's requirements in the statute (in compliance with all the rules, payment of taxes and a good safety record) should be able to own their businesses in perpetuity. No other ocean sports businesses such as Scuba diving, Commercial fishing, Catamarans, submarines are subjected to these types of restrictions. A 20 year term imposed by this statute is both discriminatory and unreasonable to our state's small business owners.

These types of businesses require significant capitalization to ensure safe operation; extensive employee training and on-going equipment investments. Please keep our tourist operations safe by encouraging experienced operators to stay in business. Please help small business by voicing your support of SB367.

We must aggressively support our state's tourism operators and keep them viable entities by removing this unfair and unreasonable restriction.

I also support to amend this bill so that it will delete the prohibition of commercial operation of thrill craft, parasailing, water sledding or high speed boating in Mauanalua Bay on weekends and holidays. This section restricts the ability of these companies to offer activities on weekends and holidays. This limits revenue which affects the state in both permit fees and taxes. This provision is also discriminatory as other similar businesses do not such a punitive operating restriction. We must support our tourist businesses, keep them viable and healthy. I urge the committee to support and readily pass these measures.

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

Senator Hee:

I write in strong support of SB 367, S.D. 1. The purpose of SB 367 is to eliminate the 20 year term limit applicable to commercial parasail and thrill craft (jetski) permits issued by the Department of Land & Natural Resources ("DLNR"). Parasail and jetski permits are the only commercial permits issued by the DLNR subject to a term limit, at the end of which the permit automatically expires and is made available for re-issuance to the general public by public auction. The current system unfairly discriminates against the incumbent operator who is forced to potentially engage in a bidding war to retain their permit and stay in business, potentially at a significantly higher cost. All other commercial permits issued by DLNR are renewed annually in perpetuity. As long as the permit holder has complied with all applicable statutes and regulations, as well as, paid all taxes owed, renewal of their permit is automatic, without risk of the permit automatically expiring, being given to another operator and without any increase in permit fees. Parasail and thrill craft operators are entitled to equal treatment and protection under the law.

The 20 year term limit unfairly handicaps a company's ability to operate successfully. A new parasail boat costs between \$100,000 - \$150,000. Each boat must



be operated by a U.S. Coast Guard licensed captain and a single trained deck hand. When you factor in hotel transportation, labor expenses, fuel, maintenance, insurance premiums, and permit and mooring fees, 20 years is not long enough for a single owner, much less a hui of investors, to recoup their investment and earn a fair rate of return.

The expiration of these permits at the end of 20 years also interferes with my company's ability to secure financing and other long term commitments. Banks are not willing to loan money, issue lines of credit and grant other privileges because the life of the operation is uncertain.

I attended the Hawaii Kai Neighborhood Board meeting last night and was disturbed to hear the high level of misinformation about this bill that is currently being circulated. This bill deals with the elimination of a twenty year limit on the permits and has nothing to do with increasing the degradation of the shoreline or of endangering the safety of kayakers that the persons opposed to this bill seem to think. Please do not be swayed by those who seek to stop this bill based upon misinformation and self-prejudices.

Last night, I heard opposition to this bill from one speaker because of a jet ski accident that caused an inexperienced jet skier to run over a kayaker, killing her. What the speaker failed to acknowledge was that the jet ski was being operated on a weekend by a residential skier who allowed his 6 year-old child to operate the jet ski and had nothing to do with any commercial operation. This accident only reinforces the need for a commercial jet ski operation in the bay during the weekends and holidays so that residents can have a controlled safe first-time experience on a jetski.

Others came to discuss how allowing commercial jet skis on the weekend would increase the degradation of the beaches at Portlock. Nothing could be further from the truth as the Commercial jet ski area is located far from the beach and across the channel. It is the residential jet skiers who run along the shoreline and across the channel.

LATE TESTIMONY

I am submitting this testimony in support of the above named Bills, which are designed to remove the unfair 20 year limit on a company's license to operate a water sports business on Maunalua Bay, and to allow licensees the opportunity to function seven days a week. Frankly, I am concerned that legislators have not communicated directly with the two licensees that would be impacted by negative legislation, so they may not know some of the pertinent facts.

It is my clear understanding that four operators used to operate "Jet Skis" in Maunalua Bay. That number is now two. There was a time when 40 units might be in the water at any given time, but that number has now been reduced to six, and the operating area is confined to a proscribed circle of 500 feet. The operators inform me that the environmental impact has been reduced by more than 70%, and all equipment meets both the emissions and noise standards established by California code, standards which are far more stringent than those of the Federal Government or the State of Hawaii. I wish I could say the same of the landscape contractors who operate weed whackers and leaf blowers at all hours in my Hawaii Kai neighborhood, without any noise or emissions abatement enforcement.

Additionally, there is evidence that the jet ski operations actually perform a vital public service in the first-response rescue of swimmers, fishermen, etc. in the Bay. One operator says his people and equipment perform rescue operations as frequently as twice a week; he asks, quite appropriately, "is the state prepared to provide that service?"

These operators, who are small business people struggling in a vicious economy, have enormous investments in equipment, facilities, personnel and marketing. To put further regulations on them would severely harm their ability to survive, make a profit that can justify their existence, and keep people at work. The two companies involved have customers among both visitors and locals. Vacationers might be able to plan their schedules around a five-day week, but most local residents cannot.

For once, let's not throw up artificial barriers to clear and hoops to jump through. Let's recognize that there are a couple of small business people who are trying their best to do things right, make a living for their families and pay their taxes. It serves no purpose to discriminate against them.
