My name is Shannon Wood, a resident of Kailua, O`ahu, speaking on my own behalf and not representing any organization in strong support of SB 382 SD1 - RELATING TO THE STADIUM AUTHORITY.

Throughout the year I attend as many meetings of the *Stadium Authority* as my schedule permits and have tracked its decisions closely for many years. I believe that modifying and reducing the power of an incumbent governor would help make sure that all the *Stadium Authority*'s decisions are made with the best interests of the people first and not because a particular member may hold political allegiance to a particular governor. This can best be accomplished by sharing the nomination process between the administrative and legislative branches of government.
