In consideration of SENATE BILL 638, SENATE DRAFT 1 RELATING TO PUBLIC LANDS

Senate Bill Number 638, Senate Draft 1 establishes a two-year moratorium on evictions and establishes a master plan advisory committee for Kahana Valley (Valley).

As the Legislature considers a variety of ideas for Kahana, the Department of Land and Natural Resources is asking that the solution be guided by the original purpose for which the Valley was purchased, as a public park. The Valley was acquired for the benefit and enjoyment of all, and it is important that, as a public park, Kahana should provide a welcoming environment for all who visit. The Valley was purchased to protect it from development, and any solution should limit future development.
