The County of Maui does not support SB690 SD1 as written. We object to being subjected to the State's proposed administrative rules and feel that their proposal contradicts the original intent of this measure which was to restore to permanent civil service employees certain rights, benefits, and privileges previously provided by law. Instead, the bill as written, while restricting movement to permanent civil service employees, requires that the movement not only be to the same or closely related class of positions, but requires that the selection process be via open-competitive recruitment....which is open to the general public as well as permanent civil service employees.

Maui County supports restoration of language for intergovernmental movement, but not this version. We also feel that intergovernmental movement should not include the federal government.
