I WOULD LIKE TO STATE MY STRONG SUPPORT OF SB 851.

THE SECTION I AM CONCERNED BEING PASSED IS IN REGARDS TO THE PAYER OF SUPPORT GOING BEHIND THE FAMILY COURT'S BACK AFTER THE COURT ORDER FOR SUPPORT ORDER WAS ISSUED AND SUBMITTING A FORM TO LOWER SUPPORT TO THE STATE CHILD SUPPORT DIVISION. THE CHILD SUPPORT OFFICE ACCEPTED IT ^{WITHOUT INVESTIGATION} AND THE HEARINGS OFFICER WILL NOT DISMISS THE CASE. WHY IS THERE AN EVIDENT LOOPHOLE IN THE LAW WHERE THE SUPPORT DIVISION CAN SUPERSEDE A STATE COURT ORDER ISSUED BY A JUDGE?

IN THIS PARTICULAR CASE THE COURT ORDER WAS FOR \$1760 A MONTH. THE SUPPORT PAYER (FATHER) PAYS, SO FAR, \$1000. MY DAUGHTER LIVES 35 MILES OUTSIDE HILLCITY. SHE HAS FIVE CHILDREN AND CANNOT FIND WORK OTHER THAN ONE HOUR CLEANING JOB. THIS LEAVES \$760 AND SHE CANNOT GET ASSISTANCE. NEGLECTLESS IS SAY IT'S PUTTING A STRAIN NOT ONLY HER FAMILY, BUT MYSELF ALSO, BOTH FINANCIALLY AND EMOTIONALLY AS HE IS NOT COOPERATING WITH THE DIVORCE & ALSO HAS A NO CONTACT RESTRAINING ORDER.
