- 1 **Department's Position:** The Department of Health strongly supports this Administration bill.
- 2 Fiscal Implications: None.
- 3 **Purpose and Justification:** This measure repeals the requirement for a sanitation certificate from the
- department to be issued for the operation of a lodging or tenement house, group home, group residence,
- 5 group living arrangement, hotel, or boardinghouse. The implementation of this measure would require
- 6 HRS 445-94 (a) be repealed.
- In the past, the certificate was required to obtain a business license for these facilities from the
- 8 City and County of Honolulu. The certificate was not required for the other counties. This requirement
- for a business license was repealed by the Legislature by Act 35, Session Laws of Hawaii 2001. There
- is no longer a need for a sanitation certificate to be issued. No impact to the public and other agencies is
- anticipated. The department will continue inspections for licensed care homes and other domiciliary
- facilities it regulates under different laws.
