My name is Charles Ota and I am the Vice President for Military Affairs at The Chamber of Commerce of Hawaii (The Chamber). I am here to state The Chamber's support of Senate Concurrent Resolution No.47 and Senate Resolution No. 28, proclaiming 2009 as the year of the Noncommissioned Officer Corps of the United States Army.
