Your Committee received testimony in support of this nominee from the Department of Commerce and Consumer Affairs, Hawaii Society of Certified Public Accountants, and one private citizen. Your Committee received a written statement and resume from the nominee. Written testimony presented to the Committee may be reviewed on the Legislature's website.

Upon review of the testimony, your Committee finds that this nominee has worked in the field of public accounting for thirty years, has been licensed as a certified public accountant for twenty-three years, and is currently the owner of a small accounting firm. Your Committee finds that, in addition to his professional experience, this nominee also has demonstrated a commitment to public service through active participation on the Kauai Community College Business Education Advisory Board.
