## SUBJECT: <u>SY 2010-2011 Facilities Assessments</u>

The annual school visitations to prioritize the major repair and maintenance (R&M) projects will begin in October 2010. The meetings will focus on a complete assessment of prioritized school needs of R&M projects. One hour of meeting time is scheduled per neighbor island school. Attached are two versions of the visitation schedule—sorted by visitation date and in calendar format.

The meetings will be led by the Building Inspection and Planning Services (BIPS) Unit of the Facilities Development Branch (FDB). The team will be reviewing the school's R&M backlog list and prioritizing the R&M projects for FY 2012 funding consideration.

The meetings are held at this time of the year because we need to establish priorities for the budget that is submitted by the Board of Education for next year's legislative session.

Please note that, similar to last year, visitations are not being made to the Oahu schools. For Oahu schools, priorities are being gathered by complex Administrative Services Assistants who are coordinating with their respective schools, with assistance from BIPS as needed. This will result in needed time savings and efficiencies for both school administrators and FDB staff. You may continue to communicate directly with your schools throughout the year regarding their repair and maintenance needs.
