A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO SAINT DAMIEN DE VEUSTER DAY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Jozef Damien de Veuster, who would later be
- 2 known as Father Damien of Molokai and Blessed Damien de Veuster,
- 3 was a Roman Catholic missionary who sacrificed his life in
- 4 service to those suffering from Hansen's Disease in Kalaupapa on
- 5 Molokai.
- on October 11, 2009, Father Damien was canonized as Saint
- 7 Jozef Damien de Veuster by His Holiness Pope Benedict XVI in
- 8 Rome. Prior to his canonization, Saint Damien was beatified on
- 9 June 4, 1995 in Brussels by His Holiness Pope John Paul II. At
- 10 the time of his beatification, Saint Damien was granted a
- memorial feast day celebrated annually on May 10.
- The purpose of this Act is to reflect Saint Damien's recent
- 13 confirmation of Sainthood, and mark his feast day as Saint
- 14 Damien de Veuster Day in Hawaii.
- 15 SECTION 2. Section 8-8, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 16 amended to read as follows:
- "[+] §8-8[] Father] Saint Damien [DeVeuster] de Veuster
- 18 Day. [April 15] May 10 of each year shall be known and

1	designated as "[Father] Saint Damien [DeVeuster] de Veuster
2	Day", provided that this day is not and shall not be construed
3	to be a state holiday."
4	SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
5	and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
6	SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
