A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO SAFETY INSPECTION OF MOTOR CARRIER VEHICLES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 286-207, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended to read as follows:

3 "§286-207 Exemptions, certain vehicles. This part shall
4 not apply to the following vehicles, if such vehicles are in
5 compliance with safety ordinances and rules of the county in
6 which they operate and other applicable state safety laws and
7 rules:

- 8 (1) The type of passenger carrying vehicle known as a
9 "sampan bus" within a radius of twenty miles from the
10 city of Hilo, Hawaii;
- 11 (2) Station wagons for the carriage of property;
- 12 (3) Trucks, truck-trailers, trailers, or other
13 nonpassenger carrying equipment having a gross vehicle
14 weight rating of 10,000 pounds or less [?], except
15 vehicles used in transporting material found by the
16 United States Secretary of Transportation to be
17 hazardous under 49 U.S.C. section 5103 and transported

1 the furtherance of their physical or mental
2 rehabilitation or for social welfare activities."

3 SECTION 2. Section 286-209, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
4 amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows:

5 "(a) Motor carrier vehicles, including but not limited to
6 trucks, truck-tractors, semitrailers, trailers, or pole
7 trailers, having a gross vehicle weight rating of more than ten
8 thousand pounds, [~~and~~] motor carrier vehicles having a gross
9 vehicle weight rating of ten thousand pounds or less which
10 transport passengers in the furtherance of a commercial
11 enterprise, including car rental transport vehicles, and motor
12 carrier vehicles used in transporting material found by the
13 United States Secretary of Transportation to be hazardous under
14 49 U.S.C. section 5103 and transported in a quantity requiring
15 placarding under 49 C.F.R., subtitle B, chapter I, subchapter C,
16 shall be inspected and certified annually."

17 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
18 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

19 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
