### A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO VOCATIONAL REHABILITATION IN WORKERS' COMPENSATION LAW.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 386-25, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended by amending subsection (e) to read as follows: 3 "(e) A provider shall file the employee's plan with the 4 approval of the employee. Upon receipt of the plan from the 5 provider, an employee shall have ten days to review and sign the The plan shall be submitted to the employer and the 6 employee and be filed with the director within two days from the 7 8 date of the employee's signature. A plan shall include a statement of the feasibility of the vocational goal, using the 9 10 process of: 11 First determining if the employee's usual and (1)12 customary employment represents suitable gainful employment, and, should it not; 13 14 (2) Next determining if modified work or other work with 15 [a different] the same employer represents suitable gainful employment, and, should it not; 16
