BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Act 224, Session Laws of Hawaii 2008, section 2 4, is amended as follows: 3 1. By amending subsection (q) to read: 4 The long term care commission shall: 5 (1)Submit an interim report to the legislature no later 6 than [February 28, 2010,] January 19, 2011, describing 7 the progress made in the development of the five-year 8 plan and preliminary proposed system reforms; and 9 Submit a final report to the legislature no later than (2) 10 [September 30, 2010,] January 18, 2012, which shall 11 include the final five-year plan, how the reforms will 12 be prioritized and phased in, and a description and final recommendations regarding the financing of long 13 14 term care services, including support for caregivers." 15 2. By amending subsection (j) to read: The term of the long term commission shall expire on 16 "(j) 17 [November 30, 2010.] adjournment sine die of the regular session 18 of the 2012 legislature."

- 2 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 3 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
