A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CONTRACTORS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that homeowners,
- 2 inspectors, and government agencies have difficulty identifying
- 3 the number of licensed tradespersons performing electrical and
- 4 plumbing work on construction job sites. Further, it may be
- 5 difficult to determine whether the ratio of licensed to
- 6 unlicensed tradesmen performing electrical and plumbing work on
- 7 construction job sites complies with the requirements of state
- 8 law.
- 9 The purpose of this Act is to provide for the
- 10 identification of licensed electricians and plumbers and the
- 11 enforcement of licensing requirements on construction job sites
- 12 to protect public safety and comply with state law.
- 13 SECTION 2. Section 444-9.5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 14 amended to read as follows:
- 15 "§444-9.5 Licensing of electrical or plumbing workers.
- 16 (a) At least half of all individuals performing electrical or
- 17 plumbing work employed on a construction job site by an
- 18 electrical or plumbing contractor shall be licensed in

- 13 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 14 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
