A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO REMOTE DISPENSING PHARMACY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that many individuals
- 2 living in underserved or remote areas need improved access to
- 3 medications and pharmacy services. Without access to a
- 4 pharmacy, individuals face tremendous barriers to obtaining
- 5 basic, much-needed medications. To permit residents on rural
- 6 islands and in remote areas to have access to a remote
- 7 dispensing pharmacy, the legislature passed Act 96, Session Laws
- 8 of Hawaii 2009.
- 9 The purpose of this Act is to clarify the definitions of
- 10 "remote dispensing machine" and "remote dispensing pharmacy" to
- 11 allow remote dispensing pharmacies to better serve these
- 12 residents.
- 13 SECTION 2. Section 461-1, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 14 amended by amending the definitions of "remote dispensing
- 15 machine" and "remote dispensing pharmacy" to read as follows:
- 16 ""Remote dispensing machine" means a device used for
- 17 dispensing unit-of-use drugs [that are acquired pursuant to
- 18 section 340B of the Public Health Service Act, Title 42 United

2	technolog	ies and is located in a remote dispensing pharmacy.
3	"Remo	ote dispensing pharmacy" means the area in an
4	institutio	onal facility, including a federally qualified health
5	center[,]	providing] that provides outpatient medical care in any
6	county, []	oy dispensing] where prescription drugs [that are
7	acquired p	oursuant to section 340B of the Public Health Service
8	Act, Title	2 42 United States Code section 256b, are dispensed
9	through the use of a remote dispensing machine."	
10	SECTION 3. Act 190, Session Laws of Hawaii 2004, is	
11	amended by	y amending section 11 to read as follows:
12	"SEC	TION 11. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2004,
13	and shall	be repealed on July 1, 2010; provided that [sections]:
14	<u>(1)</u>	Sections 328C-1, 328C-2, and 461-1, Hawaii Revised
15		Statutes, shall be reenacted in the form in which they
16		read on the day before the effective date of this
17		Act[-]; and
18	(2)	The definitions of "institutional facility" and "unit
19		of use container" shall not be repealed when section
20		461-1, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is reenacted on July
21		1, 2010, pursuant to paragraph (1)."

1	SECTION 4. Statutory material to be repealed is brackete		
2	and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.		
3	SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect upon its approval;		
4	provided that:		
5	(1) Section 3 of this Act shall take effect on June 30,		
6	2010; and		
7	(2) The definitions of "remote dispensing machine" and		
8	"remote dispensing pharmacy", as amended by this Act		
9	shall not be repealed when the amendments to section		
0	461-1, Hawaii Revised Statutes, are repealed on		
1	January 2, 2014, pursuant to section 7 of Act 212,		
2	Session Laws of Hawaii 2008, as amended by Act 96,		
3	Session Laws of Hawaii 2009.
