A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO VITAL STATISTICS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. Section 338-14.3, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
 amended by amending subsection (d) to read as follows:

3 "(d) The fee for a verification in lieu of a certified[.]
4 copy shall be <u>a maximum of</u> one half of the fee established in
5 section 338-14.5 for the first certified copy of a certificate
6 issued."

SECTION 2. Section 338-14.6, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
amended by amending subsection (b) to read as follows:

9 Moneys in the fund shall be used by the department of "(b) 10 health for the modernization and automation of the vital 11 statistics system in this State. [These proceeds shall not be 12 used to supplant any other moneys previously allocated to this 13 program necessary for the daily operation of the system of vital 14 statistics.] Moneys in the fund may be used to assist in 15 offsetting costs for the daily operations of the system of vital 16 statistics."
