A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO COMMERCIAL DRIVER LICENSING.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 Section 286-239, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is SECTION 1. 2 amended by amending subsection (q) to read as follows: 3 " (q) Commercial driver's licenses shall expire as follows: 4 (1)An initial or renewed commercial driver's license with 5 a hazardous materials endorsement shall expire no 6 later than five years from its date of issuance, 7 except if the licensee is seventy-two years of age or 8 older. The expiration date of a commercial driver's 9 license with a hazardous materials endorsement shall 10 be the same expiration date as the hazardous materials If the licensee is seventy-two years of 11 endorsement. 12 age or older, the initial or renewed commercial 13 driver's license with a hazardous materials 14 endorsement shall not exceed two years [-]; and 15 (2) All other initial commercial driver's licenses shall 16 be valid for not [less] more than [[a] two or six 17 year] an eight-year period, [beginning] expiring on 18 the driver's birthday. 1	shall be valid for not more than [[a] two or six
2	year] an eight-year period from the expiration date of
3	the previous valid license. With the exception of a
4	commercial driver's license with a hazardous materials
5	endorsement, the commercial driver's license shall
6	expire on the next birthday of the licensee occurring
7	[six] not more than eight years after the date of
8	issuance of the license unless sooner revoked,
9	suspended, or canceled; provided that, unless sooner
10	revoked, suspended, or canceled, the license shall
11	expire on the second birthday of the licensee
12	following the issuance of the license if at that time
13	the licensee is seventy-two years of age or older."
14	SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the state highway
15	fund the sum of \$8,000 or so much thereof as may be necessary
16	for fiscal year 2010-2011 for the purpose of implementing this
17	extension of the commercial driver's license to prepare for the
18	REAL ID Act.

19 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of20 transportation for the purposes of this Act.



1 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed 2 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

3 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2010.
