BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECT	TION 1. Section 286-102.6, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is						
2	amer_ded b	by amending subsection (f) to read as follows:						
3	"(f)	A provisional licensee may be issued a driver's						
4	license in accordance with this chapter if the provisional							
5	licensee:							
6	(1)	Has satisfactorily held a provisional license for at						
7		least six months[+] or has attained the age of						
8		eighteen, whichever comes first;						
9	(2)	Has no pending proceeding that might result in the						
10		suspension or revocation of the license;						
11	(3)	Is at least seventeen years of age; and						
12	(4)	Has satisfactorily complied with all requirements of						
13		this chapter."						
14	SECTION 2. Act 72, Session Laws of Hawaii 2005, is amended							
15	by a mending section 15 to read as follows:							
16	"SEC	TION 15. This Act shall take effect on January 9,						
17	2006 [; provided that on January 9, 2011, this Act shall be							
18	repealed and sections 286 102, 286 104, 286 106, 286 108,
