## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO LIMITING CIVIL LIABILITY.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Chapter 663, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is					
2	amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated					
3	and to read as follows:					
4	"§663- Owner to felon; limited liability. (a) An					
5	owner, including but not limited to a public entity, of any					
6	estate or any other interest in real property, whether					
7	possessory or nonpossessory, or any agent of the owner lawfully					
8	on the premises by consent of the owner, shall not be liable to					
9	any perpetrator engaged in any of the felonies set forth in					
10	subsection (b) for any injury or death to the perpetrator that					
11	occurs upon that property during the course of or after the					
12	commission of such felony, or when a reasonable person would					
13	believe that commission of a felony as set forth in subsection					
14	(b) is imminent; provided that if the perpetrator is injured,					
15	the perpetrator is charged with the criminal offense and					
16	convicted of the criminal offense or of a lesser included felony					
17	or misdemeanor.					

1.	<u>(b)</u>	This section applies to the following felonies:				
2	(1)	Murder in the first or second degree;				
3	(2)	Attempted murder in the first or second degree;				
4	<u>(3)</u>	Any class A felony as provided in the Hawaii Penal				
5		Code, including any attempt or conspiracy to commit a				
6		crime classified as a class A felony;				
7	(4)	Any class B felony involving violence or physical harm				
8		as provided in the Hawaii Penal Code;				
9	<u>(5)</u>	Any felony punishable by imprisonment for life;				
10	<u>(6)</u>	Any other felony in which the person inflicts serious				
11		bodily injury on another person; and				
12	<u>(7)</u>	Any felony in which the person personally used a				
13		firearm or a dangerous or deadly weapon.				
14	<u>(c)</u>	The limitation on liability under this section arises:				
15	<u>(1)</u>	At the moment the perpetrator commences the felony to				
16		which this section applies; or				
17	(2)	At the moment the owner or agent of the owner lawfully				
18		on the premises by consent of the owner believes that				
19		a commission of a felony under subsection (b) is				
20		<pre>imminent;</pre>				
21	and extend	ds to the moment the perpetrator is no longer upon the				
22	property.					



. 1	(d) The limitation on liability under this section applies					
2	only when the perpetrator's conduct in furtherance of the					
.3	3 commission of a felony specified in subsection (b) proximately					
4	4 or legally causes the injury or death.					
5	(e) This section does not limit the liability of an owner					
6	that otherwise exists for:					
7	(1) Wilful, wanton, or criminal conduct; or					
8	(2) Wilful or malicious failure to guard or warn against a					
9	dangerous condition, use, or structure; or					
10	(3) Injury or death caused to individuals other than the					
11	perpetrator of the felony.					
12	(f) Except with regard to paragraphs (e)(1) and (e)(3),					
13	the limitation of liability under this section shall not be					
14	affected by the failure of the owner to warn the perpetrator of					
15	the felony that the owner is armed and ready to cause bodily					
16	harm or death.					
17	(g) For purposes of this section, "owner" means the owner,					
18	the occupant, tenant, or anyone authorized to be on the property					
19	by the owner or the occupant, including a guest or a family or					
20	household member, employee, or agent of the owner lawfully on					

the premises.
