BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 5 SECTION 4. The sums hereinabove may be paid to the
- 6 respective persons, or for the satisfaction or settlement of the
- 7 respectively identified cases, and in several amounts
- 8 hereinabove set forth or in lesser amounts deemed appropriate,
- 9 upon checks issued by the comptroller; provided departments
- 10 shall obtain the approval of the attorney general before payment
- 11 of any claim can be made.
- 12 SECTION 5. Notwithstanding the sums hereinabove stated as
- 13 interest upon judgments against the State, payment of interest
- 14 shall be limited to the period from the date of judgment, if
- 15 applicable, to thirty days after the effective date of this Act,
- 16 as provided in section 662-8, Hawaii Revised Statutes, for those
- 17 cases to which the statute applies.
- 18 SECTION 6. All unexpended and unencumbered balances of the
- 19 appropriations made in this Act as of the close of business on
- 20 June 30, 2011, shall lapse.
- 21 SECTION 7. If any provision of this Act, or the
- 22 application thereof to any person or circumstance is held

- 1 invalid, the invalidity does not affect other provisions or
- 2 applications of the Act, which can be given effect without the
- 3 invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions
- 4 of this Act are severable.
- 5 SECTION 8. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
