## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CIVIL DEFENSE.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Chapter 128, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
3	and to read as follows:
4	" <u>§128-</u> <u>Statewide communications interoperability</u>
5	coordinator; establishment; responsibilities. (a) There is
6	established within the civil defense agency the position of
7	statewide communications interoperability coordinator, which
8	shall be a full-time position exempt from chapters 76 and 89.
9	(b) The statewide communications interoperability
10	coordinator shall have the following areas of responsibility:
11	(1) Outreach, which shall include:
12	(A) Establishing and maintaining a database of
13	subject matter experts and stakeholders across
14	the State;
15	(B) Acting as liaison among the federal government,
16	state agencies and officials, and state and
17	county emergency response communities;

2			government for the federal government and
3			industry on statewide interoperable
4			communications; and
5		<u>(D)</u>	Attending national interoperability conferences
6			and workshops;

9		<u>(A)</u>	Leveraging all components of the statewide
10			governance structure to facilitate the
11			development of a statewide communications
12			interoperability plan; and
13		<u>(B)</u>	Coordinating the effort to implement the
14			statewide communications interoperability plan by
15			setting timelines and project plans for making
16			progress on the initiatives;
17	<u>(3)</u>	Gran	t management and policy development, which
18		incl	udes:
19		<u>(A)</u>	Coordinating with other elements of the civil
20			defense agency to monitor the State's
21			interoperable communications grant opportunities;

1	<u>(B)</u>	Seeking additional grant funding opportunities			
2		for statewide interoperable communications

4		through the civil defense agency; and

7	(A)	Measuring progress and results, and revising the			
8		statewide communications interoperability plan,

15	SECTION 2	. There is authorized a federal fund ceiling			
16	increase of \$110,000 for the civil defense agency to accommodat				
17	federal funds	received under the homeland security grant			
18	program.				
19	SECTION 3	. There is appropriated out of the federal funds			
20	received under	the homeland security grant program the sum of			
21	\$110,000 or so	much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year

- 7 provided that section 3 shall take effect on July 1, 2010.
