A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE JUDICIARY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- SECTION 1. This Act shall be known and may be cited as the
 Judiciary Supplemental Appropriations Act of 2010.

 SECTION 2. Act 139, Session Laws of Hawaii 2009, is
- 4 amended by amending part II to read as follows:
- 5 "PART II. PROGRAM APPROPRIATIONS
- 6 SECTION 3. The following sums, or so much thereof as may
- 7 be sufficient to accomplish the purposes and programs designated
- 8 herein, are appropriated or authorized from the sources of
- 9 funding specified to the judiciary for the fiscal biennium
- 10 beginning July 1, 2009, and ending June 30, 2011. The total
- 11 expenditures and the number of permanent positions established
- 12 in each fiscal year of the fiscal biennium shall not exceed the
- 13 sums and the position ceilings indicated for each year, except
- 14 as provided in this Act.

- 1 SECTION 3. Part V, section 10, of Act 139, Session Laws of
- 2 Hawaii 2009, is amended to read as follows:
- 3 "SECTION 10. Any law to the contrary notwithstanding, the
- 4 appropriations under Act 169, Session Laws of Hawaii 2007,
- 5 section 15, as amended and renumbered by Act 102, Session Laws
- 6 of Hawaii 2008, section 4, in the amounts indicated or balances
- 7 thereof, unallotted, allotted, unencumbered, or encumbered and
- 8 unrequired, are hereby lapsed:

- 13 SECTION 4. If any portion of this Act or its application
- 14 to any person or circumstances is held to be invalid for any
- 15 reason, the remainder of the Act and any provision thereof shall
- 16 not be affected. If any portion of a specific appropriation is
- 17 held to be invalid for any reason, the remaining portion shall
- 18 be independent of the invalid portion and shall be expended to
- 19 fulfill the objective and intent of the appropriation to the
- 20 extent possible.
- 21 SECTION 5. If any manifest clerical, typographical, or
- 22 other mechanical error is found in this Act, the chief justice

- ${f 1}$ is authorized to correct the error. All changes made pursuant
- 2 to this section shall be reported to the legislature at its next
- 3 regular session.
- 4 SECTION 6. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 5 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 6 SECTION 7. This Act shall take effect upon approval.
