A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO VIOLENCE AGAINST HEALTH CARE PERSONNEL.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Section 707-711, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is	
2	amended by amending subsection (1) to read as follows:	
3	"(1)	A person commits the offense of assault in the second
4	degree if:	
5	(a)	The person intentionally or knowingly causes
6		substantial bodily injury to another;
7	(b)	The person recklessly causes serious or substantial
8		bodily injury to another;
9	(c)	The person intentionally or knowingly causes bodily
10		injury to a correctional worker, as defined in section
11		710-1031(2), who is engaged in the performance of duty
12		or who is within a correctional facility;
13	(d)	The person intentionally or knowingly causes bodily
14		injury to another with a dangerous instrument;
15	(e)	The person intentionally or knowingly causes bodily
16		injury to an educational worker who is engaged in the
17		performance of duty or who is within an educational
18		facility. For the purposes of this paragraph,

1 "educational worker" means: any administrator, specialist, counselor, teacher, or employee of the 2 3 department of education or an employee of a charter school; a person who is a volunteer, as defined in 4 section 90-1, in a school program, activity, or 5 function that is established, sanctioned, or approved 6 by the department of education; or a person hired by 7 the department of education on a contractual basis and 8 9 engaged in carrying out an educational function; 10 (f) The person intentionally or knowingly causes bodily injury to any emergency medical services [personnel] 11 12 provider who is engaged in the performance of duty. For the purposes of this paragraph, "emergency medical 13 14 services [personnel" shall have the same meaning as in 15 section 321-222;] provider" means emergency medical services personnel, as defined in section 321-222, and 16 17 physicians, physician's assistants, nurses, nurse practitioners, certified registered nurse 18 19 anesthetists, respiratory therapists, laboratory technicians, radiology technicians, and social 20 workers, providing services in the emergency room of a 21 hospital; or 22

SECTION 3. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
begun before its effective date.

20 SECTION 4. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
21 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

22 SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
