A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO HEALTH INSURANCE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 431, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended by adding a new section to article 10A to be
- 3 appropriately designated and to read as follows:
- 4 "\$431:10A- Colon cancer screening coverage. (a) Each
- 5 policy of accident and health or sickness insurance providing
- 6 coverage for health care, except for policies that only provide
- 7 coverage for specified diseases or other limited benefit
- 8 coverage, shall provide coverage for colorectal-cancer screening
- 9 by all A and B grade screening modalities as recommended by the
- 10 United States Preventive Services Task Force.
- 11 (b) Beginning March 1, 2011, all health insurance
- 12 providers in Hawaii shall inform their insured about the risk
- 13 associated with undiagnosed colorectal-cancer and encourage the
- 14 insured to consult with the insured's physician about available
- 15 screening options."

- 1 SECTION 2. Chapter 432, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended by adding a new section to part VI of article 1 to be
- 3 appropriately designated and to read as follows:
- 4 "S432:1- Colon cancer screening coverage. (a) All
- 5 individual and group hospital and medical service contracts
- 6 providing health care coverage shall provide coverage for
- 7 colorectal-cancer screening by all A and B grade screening
- 8 modalities as recommended by the United States Preventive
- 9 Services Task Force.
- 10 (b) Beginning March 1, 2011, all health insurance
- 11 providers in Hawaii shall inform their insured of the risk
- 12 associated with undiagnosed colorectal cancer and encourage the
- 13 insured to consult with the insured's physician about available
- 14 screening options."
- 15 SECTION 3. Section 432D-23, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 16 amended to read as follows:
- 17 "\$432D-23 Required provisions and benefits.
- 18 Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, each
- 19 policy, contract, plan, or agreement issued in the [State] state
- 20 after January 1, 1995, by health maintenance organizations
- 21 pursuant to this chapter, shall include benefits provided in
- 22 sections 431:10-212, 431:10A-115, 431:10A-115.5, 431:10A-116,

- 1 431:10A-116.5, 431:10A-116.6, 431:10A-119, 431:10A-120,
- 2 431:10A-121, 431:10A-125, [and] 431:10A-126, and 431:10A- , and
- 3 chapter 431M."
- 4 SECTION 4. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 5 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 6 SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect upon approval and
- 7 shall apply to policies, contracts, and plans of health
- 8 insurance issued or renewed after January 1, 2011.
