RELATING TO EDUCATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. Section 302A-1134, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
amended by amending subsection (c) to read as follows:

3 "(c) [No-child who is seventeen years of age or over shall

4 be admitted to the ninth grade of a public four year high

5 school, and no-child who is eighteen years of age or over shall

6 be admitted-to the tenth grade of a public senior high school,

7 except-upon the written permission of the superintendent when in

8 the superintendent's opinion the facts warrant admission.] No

9 person who is twenty years of age or over on the first

10 instructional day of the school year shall be eligible to attend

a public school. If a person reaches twenty years of age after

12 the first instructional day of the school year, the person shall

13 be eligible to attend public school for the full school year."

SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketedand stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

16 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2010.
