RELATING TO THE TAX REVIEW COMMISSION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. Section 232E-3, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
amended to read as follows:

"§232E-3 Duties. The commission shall conduct a 3 systematic review of the State's tax structure, using such 4 standards as equity and efficiency. Thirty days prior to the 5 6 convening of the second regular session of the legislature after 7 the members of the commission have been appointed, the 8 commission shall submit to the legislature an evaluation of the 9 State's tax structure and recommend revenue and tax policy, 10 except that for the commission appointed on or before July 1, 1980, or the replacement commission intended to function prior 11 to the appointment of a new commission on or before July 1, 12 1985, the commission shall submit the required evaluation and 13 recommendations to the legislature thirty days prior to the 14 convening of the regular session of 1985[-,], and except that for 15 16 the commission appointed on or before July 1, 2005, or the 17 replacement commission intended to function prior to the appointment of a new commission on July 1, 2010, the commission 18

1	shall reconvene to review its evaluation and recommendations
