A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CERTAIN FUNDS UNDER THE DEPARTMENT OF LABOR AND INDUSTRIAL RELATIONS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 383-121, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended to read as follows:
- 3 "\$383-121 Unemployment compensation fund; establishment
- 4 and control. There is established in the treasury of the State
- 5 as a [special] trust fund, separate and apart from all public
- 6 moneys or funds of the State, an unemployment compensation fund,
- 7 which shall be administered by the department of labor and
- 8 industrial relations exclusively for the purposes of this
- 9 chapter. All contributions pursuant to this chapter shall be
- 10 paid into the fund and all compensation and benefits payable
- 11 pursuant to this chapter shall be paid from the fund. All
- 12 moneys in the fund shall be mingled and undivided. The fund
- 13 shall consist of:
- 14 (1) All contributions collected pursuant to this chapter;
- 15 (2) Interest earned on any moneys in the fund;
- 16 (3) Any property or securities acquired through the use of
- moneys belonging to the fund;

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         SECTION 2. Section 386-151, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
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    amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows:
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               There is hereby created a trust fund to be known as
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    the special compensation fund which shall consist of payments
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    made to it as provided by law. The director of finance of the
    State shall be custodian of the fund, and all disbursements
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    therefrom shall be paid by the director of finance upon orders
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    by the director of labor and industrial relations."
         SECTION 3. Section 392-61, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
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    amended to read as follows:
         "[+] §392-61[+] Establishment of [special] trust fund for
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    disability benefits. There is established in the treasury of
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    the State, separate and apart from all public moneys or funds of
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    the State, a [special] trust fund for disability benefits which
    shall be administered by the director exclusively for the
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    purposes of this chapter [-], including for the automation of the
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1 workers compensation, temporary disability insurance, and prepaid health care programs. All contributions pursuant to 2 this part shall be paid into the fund and all benefits payable 3 under this part shall be paid from the fund. The fund shall 4 consist of: 5 6 (1)[all] All contributions collected pursuant to this 7 part, together with any interest thereon; 8 (2)[all] All fines and penalties for the fund pursuant to 9 this chapter; 10 (3)[all] All moneys collected by way of subrogation; [interest] Interest earned on any moneys in the fund; 11 (4)[any] Any property or securities acquired through the 12 (5)13 use of moneys belonging to the fund; 14 (6)[all] All earnings of such property and securities; 15 and [all] All other moneys received for the fund from any 16 (7)17 source." 18 SECTION 4. Section 393-41, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 19 amended to read as follows: "[+]393-41[+] Establishment of [special] premium 20 supplementation fund. There is established in the treasury of 21

the State, separate and apart from all public moneys or funds of

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- 1 the State, a [special] trust fund for premium supplementation
- 2 which shall be administered exclusively for the purposes of this
- 3 chapter. All premium supplementations payable under this part
- 4 shall be paid from the fund. The fund shall consist of:
- 5 (1) [all money] All moneys appropriated by the State for
- 6 the purposes of premium supplementation under this
- 7 part; and
- **8** (2) [all] All fines and penalties collected pursuant to

- 10 SECTION 5. There is appropriated out of the trust fund for
- 11 disability benefits available funds in the sum of \$ or so
- 12 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2009-2010 for
- 13 the automation of the workers' compensation, temporary
- 14 disability insurance, and prepaid health care programs.
- 15 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
- 16 labor and industrial relations for the purposes of this Act.
- 17 SECTION 6. To conform to the change in the name "special
- 18 fund for disability benefits" to "trust fund for disability
- 19 benefits," the title of chapter 392, part IV, Hawaii Revised
- 20 Statutes, and sections 392-28(3) and (4), 392-42.5(b), 392-43(f)
- 21 and (g), 392-45, 392-46, 392-47, 392-52, 392-62, 392-63, 392-64,
- 22 392-65, 392-67, 392-69, 392-72(a), 392-78(d), and 392-92(b),

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- 1 Hawaii Revised Statutes, are amended by substituting the word
- 2 "trust fund" or like term, wherever the word "special fund" or
- 3 like term appears, as the context requires.
- 4 SECTION 7. To conform to the change in the name "special
- 5 fund for premium supplementation" to "trust fund for premium
- 6 supplementation, "sections 393-33(a) and 393-34(b), Hawaii
- 7 Revised Statutes, are amended by substituting the word "trust
- 8 fund" or like term, wherever the word "special fund" or like
- 9 term appears, as the context requires.
- 10 SECTION 8. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 11 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 12 SECTION 9. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2020.
