RELATING TO COPIES IN THE BUREAU OF CONVEYANCES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 502-21, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended to read as follows:
- 3 "\$502-21 Recording of plans unlawful. It shall not be
- 4 lawful for the registrar to accept for record any plan of land,
- 5 whether attached to, made a part of, or independent of, any
- 6 deed, certified copy of judgment of condemnation, or other
- 7 instrument; to the end and purpose that there shall be no plans
- 8 recorded in the record books, but in substitution therefor there
- 9 shall be a single method of filing plans in the archives of the
- 10 bureau of conveyances; provided that where sketches, blueprints,
- or plans of land of a size not larger than 8 1/2 inches by 14
- 12 inches which legibly reproduces under photographic, electronic,
- 13 or electrostatic methods are attached to instruments and made a
- 14 part thereof by reference to the same in the instrument, the
- 15 registrar may record the same in the record books by means of
- 16 the photographic recorder, on payment of the fee as provided in
- 17 section 502-25."

- 1 SECTION 2. Section 502-22, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended to read as follows:
- 3 "§502-22 Copies of plans furnished by registrar. The
- 4 registrar shall furnish, when so requested, copies of any map or
- 5 plan filed in accordance with sections 502-17 to 502-21, duly
- 6 certified by the registrar's seal of office, upon payment of the
- 7 fee hereinafter mentioned. In addition, the registrar may
- 8 authorize the department of accounting and general services to
- 9 furnish, when so requested, copies of such maps or plans,
- 10 subject to the payment of fees applicable to maps or plans
- 11 furnished by the registrar. These copies of maps or plans may
- 12 be furnished in photographic, electronic, or electrostatic
- 13 form."
- 14 SECTION 3. Section 502-26, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 15 amended to read as follows:
- 16 "§502-26 Copies of instruments, certificates. The
- 17 registrar, when applied to, shall furnish an attested copy of
- 18 any instrument or document recorded in the registrar's office,
- 19 or of any fact appearing upon the registrar's records. The
- 20 registrar may also issue nonattested documents or portions of
- 21 any instrument or document recorded in the registrar's office[-]
- 22 in photographic, electronic, or electrostatic form. The

- 1 registrar may issue certificates of search or incumbrance when
- 2 personnel is available for the making of the certificate."
- 3 SECTION 4. Section 502-92, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 4 amended to read as follows:
- 5 "§502-92 Copies of old records. The registrar shall
- 6 prepare photographic, electronic, or electrostatic copies of the
- 7 records and record books in the bureau of conveyances which by
- 8 reason of age, usage, or otherwise are in such condition that
- 9 they can no longer be conveniently used or consulted without
- 10 danger of destruction thereof, and certify to the correctness of
- 11 such copies. The certified copies, and prints made from them
- 12 and similarly certified, may be read in evidence with the same
- 13 force and effect as the original instrument. The correctness of
- 14 such copies is not conclusive but may be rebutted. All such
- 15 records and record books from which the copies are made shall be
- 16 deposited with the department of accounting and general services
- 17 in its public archives. The registrar may convert into
- 18 electronic form information or documents recorded before the
- 19 registrar began to record electronic documents."

- 21 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
