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### A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO HARBORS.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECT	ION 1. Section 266-3, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended t	o read as follows:
3	"§26	6-3 Rules. (a) The director of transportation may
4	adopt rul	es as necessary to:
5	(1)	Regulate the manner in which all vessels may enter and
6		moor, anchor, or dock in the commercial harbors,
7		ports, and roadsteads of the State, or move from one
8		dock, wharf, pier, quay, bulkhead, landing, anchorage,
9		or mooring to another within the commercial harbors,
10		ports, or roadsteads;
11	(2)	[The examination, guidance, and control of] Examine,
12		guide, and control harbor masters and their assistants
13		and their conduct while on duty;
14	(3)	[The embarking or disembarking] Control the
15		embarkation or disembarkation of passengers;
16	(4)	[ <del>The</del> ] <u>Regulate the</u> expeditious and careful handling of
17		freight, goods, wares, and merchandise of every kind

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1		[ <del>which</del> ] <u>that</u> may be delivered for shipment or
2		discharged on the commercial docks, wharves, piers,
3		quays, bulkheads, or landings belonging to or
4		controlled by the State; and
5	(5)	[ <del>Defining</del> ] <u>Define</u> the duties and powers of carriers,
6		shippers, and consignees respecting passengers,
7		freight, goods, wares, and merchandise in and upon the
8		docks, wharves, piers, quays, bulkheads, or landings
9		within the commercial harbors, ports, and roadsteads
10		of the State. The director may also make further
11		rules for the safety of the docks, wharves, piers,
12		quays, bulkheads, and landings on, in, near, or
13		affecting a commercial harbor and waterfront
14		improvements belonging to or controlled by the State.
15	(b)	The director may also adopt, amend, and repeal such
16	rules as	are necessary:
17	(1)	For the proper regulation and control of all shipping
18		in the commercial harbors belonging to or controlled
19		by the State, and of the entry, departure, mooring,
20		and berthing of vessels therein, and for the

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1		regulation and control of all other matters and things
2		connected with such shipping;
3	(2)	To prevent the discharge or throwing into commercial
4		harbors of rubbish, refuse, garbage, or other
5		substances likely to affect water quality or that
6		contribute to making [such] commercial harbors
7		unsightly, unhealthful, or unclean, or that are liable
8		to fill up shoal or shallow waters in, near, or
9		affecting the commercial harbors; and
10	(3)	To prevent the escape of fuel or other oils or
11		substances into the waters in, near, or affecting
12		commercial harbors from any source point, including[ $_{ au}$
13		but not limited to,] any vessel or pipes or storage
14		tanks upon the land.
15	(c)	The director may also adopt, amend, and repeal rules
16	necessary	to require any person who uses or occupies State
17	harbor pr	operty to defend, indemnify, and hold harmless the
18	State and	any of its agencies, officers, and employees from and
19	against a	ll liability, loss, damage, cost and expense, including
20	all attor	neys' fees, and all claims, suits, and demands
21	therefore	, arising out of or resulting from such use or

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1	occupation, and to condition the use or occupation of State		
2	harbor property on the waiver of any statutory or other immunity		
3	from liability that may be asserted in any way to limit such		
4	person's obligation to so defend, indemnify, and hold harmless		
5	the State, and any of its agencies, officers, and employees.		
6	Nothing herein shall be construed to prevent the State from		
7	being held liable for any damages, costs, and expenses to the		
8	extent caused by the State's negligence or other fault, breach		
9	of contract, or failure to comply with statutory or other legal		
10	duty relating to State harbor property and paying for such		
11	damages, costs, and expenses provided there is an appropriation		
12	therefor.		
13	(d) For the purposes of this section, "State harbor		
14	property" means the commercial harbors, ports, roadsteads,		
15	harbor buildings, and other harbor facilities of the State,		
16	including docks, wharves, piers, quays, bulkheads, or landings		
17	therein.		
18	[ <del>(c)</del> ] <u>(e)</u> The rules shall be adopted in the manner		
19	prescribed in chapter 91 and shall have the force and effect of		

20 law."

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1	SECTION 2. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
2	matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
3	begun before its effective date.
4	SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
5	and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
6	SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2046.

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#### Report Title:

Commercial Harbors; Indemnification

#### Description:

Authorizes the Director of Transportation to require any person who uses or occupies state commercial harbors for business or commercial purposes, to defend, indemnify, and hold harmless the State against claims that may arise from such use or occupation. (HB1163 HD2)
