### A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE HOMELESS.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that many homeless 2 persons in the State are presently stranded in the State, are separated from their families and relatives in their home state, 3 4 but lack independent financial resources for reuniting with 5 those family members. 6 The purpose of this Act is to establish a return-to-home 7 program for the homeless. 8 SECTION 2. Chapter 356D, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 9 amended by adding a new subpart to part VII to be appropriately 10 designated and to read as follows: 11 " . RETURN-TO-HOME PROGRAM 12 Return-to-home program. (a) There is 13 established within the authority a voluntary homeless assistance 14 program to be known as the return-to-home program, to provide 15 the eligible homeless with assistance in being reunited with their families and relatives in the person's home state. 16 authority shall administer the program and adopt the standards 17

and framework necessary to implement the program.

4	(2)	The person has a support system in place in the

8		court hearing or sentencing, has proper clearance from
9		the court to participate in the program; and
10	(4)	The person is indigent and lacks the financial
11		resources necessary to secure transportation to return
12		to the person's home state.
13	(c)	The authority shall actively seek the participation of
14	local air	lines, cruise lines, charter companies, homeless
15	programs,	travel agencies, and the visitor industry to implement
16	and coordinate the program.	
17	(d)	The authority shall also assist program participants
18	with nece	ssary and proper preparations for the return trip,
19	including	proper identification, orientation relating to airport
20	security,	and the basics of personal care, and shall follow up
21	with them	within one month of their return to their home state

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- 1 to assess their efforts at successful reunification with their
- 2 families and relatives."
- 3 SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the general
- 4 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$75,000 or so much
- 5 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2009-2010 and the
- 6 same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year
- 7 2010-2011 for implementing the costs of the return-to-home
- 8 program, including program costs and the hiring of necessary
- 9 staff.
- 10 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the Hawaii
- 11 public housing authority for the purposes of this Act.
- 12 SECTION 4. New statutory material is underscored.
- 13 SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2009.
