10	until twenty-four hours prior to the close of filing for that		
11	office, as established under section 12-6; provided that [in the		
12	case of a special primary or special election, nomination papers		
13	shall be made available at least ten days prior to the close of		
14	filing.]:		
15	(1) In the case of a special primary or special election,		
16	nomination papers shall be made available from at		
17	least ten days prior to the close of filing until		
18	twenty-four hours prior to the close of filing; and
