A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO RELIGIOUS FREEDOM DAY IN HAWAII.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that religious conflict
- 2 is one of the most dangerous social conditions in the world and
- 3 religiously motivated violence is a threat to world peace and
- 4 economic stability. During a time of increasing religious
- 5 strife, it is important to build public awareness and support
- 6 for religious freedom and to learn to live together despite
- 7 religious differences. Religious freedom recognizes the right
- 8 of each person to determine their own religion, or lack thereof,
- 9 the right to associate and assemble together for public worship,
- 10 and the right to change one's religious belief.
- 11 SECTION 2. Chapter 8, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended
- 12 by adding a new section to be appropriately designated and to
- 13 read as follows:
- 14 "\$8- Religious freedom day in Hawaii. The second
- 15 Saturday in July of each year shall be known and designated as
- 16 "Religious Freedom Day in Hawaii". This day is not and shall
- 17 not be construed as a state holiday."
- 18 SECTION 3. New statutory material is underscored.
