BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 10-3, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended to read as follows: 3 "§10-3 Purpose of the office. The purposes of the office of Hawaiian affairs include: 4 5 The betterment of conditions of native Hawaiians. A (1)6 pro rata portion of all funds derived from the public 7 land trust shall be funded in an amount to be 8 determined by the legislature for this purpose, and 9 shall be held and used solely as a public trust for 10 the betterment of the conditions of native Hawaiians. For [the purpose] purposes of this chapter, the public 11 12 land trust shall be all proceeds and income from the 13 sale, lease, or other disposition of lands ceded to 14 the United States by the Republic of Hawaii under the 15 joint resolution of annexation, approved July 7, 1898 16 (30 Stat. 750), or acquired in exchange for lands so 17 ceded, and conveyed to the State of Hawaii by virtue 18 of section 5(b) of the Act of March 18, 1959 (73 Stat.
