BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECT	ION 1. Chapter 237, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated

4	" <u>§</u> 23	7- Public school; tax free week. (a) The seven
5	days befo	re public school instruction begins every year shall be
6	designate	d a general excise tax free week. During that week,
7	amounts received from all purchases of the following items for	
8	use by students returning to schools shall be exempt from the	
9	general excise tax:	
10	(1)	Any article of apparel, including clothes, footwear,
11		watches, watchband, handkerchiefs, and umbrellas;
12		provided the cost of the articles do not exceed \$50;

14	(2)	All school supplies, including pens, pencils, erasers,
15		crayons, notebooks, paper, legal pads, composition
16		books, poster paper, scissors, cellophane tape, glue
17		or paste, rulers, computer discs, protractors,

1	compasses, and calculators; provided that the cost of		
2	each school supply item does not exceed \$10.		
3	(b) This section shall not apply to any item or apparel		
4	sold at theme parks, public lodging establishments, or airports.		
5	(c) The department of taxation shall adopt rules pursuant		
6	to chapter 91 to administer this section, including reporting		
7	requirements for retailers.		
8	(d) On July 1 of each year, the superintendent of		
9	education shall publish a notice statewide as provided in		
10	section 1-28.5 announcing a single specific date upon which		
11	public school instruction is scheduled to begin. For purposes		
12	of this section, the published date shall be the controlling		
13	date, regardless of the date that instruction actually begins at		
14	any particular public school."		
15	SECTION 2. New statutory material is underscored.		
16	SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval		
17	and apply to taxable years beginning after December 31, 2008.
