A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Chapter 281, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
3	and to read as follows:
4	"§281- Malt beverages; labeling; product placement.
5	(a) By January 1, 2011, each commission shall adopt rules
6	requiring covered beverage containers to bear a distinctive,
7	uniform, and prominently displayed label, or a firmly affixed
8	sticker to be applied by the manufacturer prior to delivery to
9	the wholesaler, containing the following information:
10	(1) The alcohol content of the covered beverage; and
11	(2) The phrase: "Attention: Contains Alcohol";
12	in a size, format, and form determined by the commission.
13	(b) Each commission shall adopt rules establishing product
14	placement requirements designed to minimize consumer confusion
15	in identifying a beverage as alcoholic or nonalcoholic,
16	including:

1	(1)	Restrictions on the placement of covered beverages	
2		within a certain proximity of nonalcoholic beverages;	
3		and	
4	(2)	Mandatory signage posted at retail displays of covered	
5		beverages and indicating that the beverages contain	
6		alcohol.	
7	(c)	For the purposes of this section, "covered beverage"	
8	means any	alcoholic beverage sold for consumption within this	
9	state as	a malt beverage and using a container design that the	
10	commission determines may be mistaken by a reasonable person for		
11	nonalcoholic beverage products such as energy drinks, colas,		
12	sodas, fr	uit drinks, and gelatins."	
13	SECT	ION 2. New statutory material is underscored.	
14	SECT	ION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
