BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECT	ION 1. Section 523A-15, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended b	y amending subsection (a) to read as follows:
3	"(a)	A person, excluding another state, claiming property
4	paid or delivered to the administrator may file a claim on a	
5	form prescribed by the administrator and verified by the	
6	claimant.	If a claimant is unable to present requested
7	documentation of ownership to the director, then the claimant	
8	may assert ownership through a notarized affidavit signed under	
9	penalty of unsworn falsification to authorities, punishable	
10	under section 710-1063, and verifying that the following	
11	information is true:	
12	(1)	The claimant's residence was previously the address
13		associated, if applicable, with the unclaimed
14		property;
15	(2)	The claimant is the intended recipient of the
16		unclaimed property; and

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1	(3) In the case of an uncashed check, the claimant
2	maintained a business relationship with the check's
3	issuer at or near the time of issue;
4	provided that no person may assert ownership solely through an
5	affidavit under this subsection over unclaimed property with a
6	fair market value over \$. The claimant's signature
7	shall appear at the bottom of the affidavit. This subsection
8	shall not affect any other requirements for claiming unclaimed
9	property under this chapter."
10	SECTION 2. New statutory material is underscored.
11	SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2009.
