## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE NATURAL ENERGY LABORATORY OF HAWAII AUTHORITY.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- SECTION 1. Section 227D-2, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 1 amended by amending subsections (a) and (b) to read as follows: 2 "(a) There is established the natural energy laboratory of 3 Hawaii authority, which shall be a body corporate and politic and an instrumentality and agency of the State. The authority 5 shall be placed within the [department of business, economic 6 development, and tourism] department of budget and finance for 7 administrative purposes, pursuant to section 26-35. The purpose 8 of the natural energy laboratory of Hawaii authority shall be to 9 facilitate research, development, and commercialization of 10 natural energy resources and ocean-related research, technology, 11 and industry in Hawaii and to engage in retail, commercial, or 12 tourism activities that will financially support that research, 13 development, and commercialization at a research and technology 14 park in Hawaii. Its duties shall include: 15
- 16 (1) Establishing, managing, and operating facilities that
  17 provide sites for:

1		(A) Research and development;
2		(B) Commercial projects and businesses [utilizing]

5		(C) Compatible businesses engaged in scientific and

5	(b) The governing body of the authority shall consist of a
6	board of directors having [eleven] thirteen voting members[-
7	Three members from the general public shall be appointed by the
8	governor for staggered terms pursuant to section 26-34, except
9	that one of these members shall be a resident of the county of
10	Hawaii. The members shall be selected on the basis of their
11	knowledge, interest, and proven expertise in, but not limited
12	to, one or more of the following fields: finance, commerce and
13	trade, corporate management, marketing, economics, engineering,
14	energy management, real estate development, property management,
15	aquaculture, and ocean science. The chairperson and secretary
16	of the research advisory committee shall serve on the board.
17	The director of business, economic development, and tourism, the
18	chairperson of the board of land and natural resources, the
19	president of the University of Hawaii, the mayor of the county
20	of Hawaii, an appointed member from the board of the high
21	technology development corporation, and an appointed member from
22	the board of the Hawaii strategic development corporation, or

12	(4)	The tenants of the natural energy laboratory of Hawaii
13		authority shall elect two members from among the
14		tenants of the authority, of whom one member shall
15		serve a two-year term, and one member shall serve a
16		four-year term. Each tenant shall be entitled to cast
17		one vote for each member position. The tenant members
18		shall be disqualified from voting on setting lease
19		rents, water rates, or utility rates, but may
20		participate in discussions.

- 2 until the board of directors selects a chairperson."
- 3 SECTION 2. All appointments for the board of directors of
- 4 the natural energy laboratory of Hawaii authority shall be made
- 5 by October 1, 2009, pursuant to the criteria for appointments
- 6 set forth in section 227D-2, Hawaii Revised Statutes. The
- 7 previously seated members of the natural energy laboratory of
- 8 Hawaii authority board of directors shall be discharged
- 9 effective upon the convening of the first meeting of the new
- 10 board of directors.
- 11 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 12 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2112.
