BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 605-14, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended to read as follows:

3 "§605-14 Unauthorized practice of law prohibited. It 4 shall be unlawful for any person, firm, association, or 5 corporation to engage in or attempt to engage in or to offer to 6 engage in the practice of law, or to do or attempt to do or 7 offer to do any act constituting the practice of law, except and 8 to the extent that the person, firm, or association is licensed 9 or authorized so to do by an appropriate court, agency, or office or by a statute of the State or of the United States. 10 Nothing in sections 605-14 to 605-17 contained shall be 11 12 construed to prohibit the preparation or use by any party to a 13 transaction of any legal or business form or document used in 14 the transaction.

15 This section shall not apply to real estate licensees
16 acting within the scope of a real estate transaction."
