A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO VETERANS RIGHTS AND BENEFITS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Chapter 363, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is		
2	amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated		
3	and to read as follows:		
4	"§363- Demonstrations at cemeteries; prohibited;		
5	penalties. (a) No person may carry out a demonstration on the		
6	property of a cemetery that has received funds through the		
7	office unless the demonstration has been approved by the council		
8	of the county in which the cemetery is located.		
9	(b) No person shall receive approval to carry out a		
10	demonstration during the period beginning sixty minutes before		
11	and ending sixty minutes after a funeral, memorial service, or		
12	ceremony is held, any part of which demonstration:		
13	(1) Takes place within one hundred and fifty feet of a		
14	road, pathway, or other route of ingress to or egress		
15	from the cemetery property, and includes, as part of		
16	the demonstration, any individual wilfully making or		
17	assisting in the making of any noise or diversion that		

1		disturbs or tends to disturb the peace or good order
2		of the funeral, memorial service, or ceremony; or
3	(2)	Is within three hundred feet of the cemetery and
4		impedes the access to or egress from the cemetery.
5	(b)	For purposes of this section, "demonstration" means:
6	(1)	Any picketing or similar conduct;
7	(2)	Any oration, speech, use of sound amplification
8		equipment or device, or similar conduct that is not
9		part of a funeral, memorial service, or ceremony;
10	(3)	The display of any placard, banner, flag, or similar
11		device, unless such a display is part of a funeral,
12		memorial service, or ceremony; or
13	(4)	The distribution of any handbill, pamphlet, leaflet,
14		or other written or printed matter other than a
15		program distributed as part of a funeral, memorial
16		service, or ceremony.
17	(c)	Any person who violates this section shall be guilty
18	of a pett	y misdemeanor."
19	SECT	ION 2. New statutory material is underscored.
20	SECT	ION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
