A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO INVASIVE SPECIES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Chapter 150A, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
3	and to read as follows:
4	"§150A- Failure to pay or remit the inspection,
5	quarantine, and eradication service fee; fines. (a) The
6	following fines shall be imposed for failure to pay, bill, or
7	remit the inspection, quarantine, and eradication service fee as
8	provided for in section 150A-5.3:
9	(1) A person responsible for paying the freight charges to
10	the transportation company who does not pay the fee
11	shall be assessed a fine of \$100 for every one
12	thousand pounds of freight or part thereof; and
13	(2) A transportation company that does not:
14	(A) Bill the fee to the person responsible for paying
15	the freight charges to the transportation company
16	within fifteen days of the delivery of the
17	freight; or

1	(B) Remit the fee to the department within forty-five
2	days of collecting the fee from the person
3	responsible for paying the freight charges to the
4	transportation company,
5	shall pay a fine of \$100 for every one thousand pounds
6	of freight or part thereof.
7	(b) All fines shall be paid to the department and
8	deposited into the pest inspection, quarantine, and eradication
9	fund under section 150A-4.5."
10	SECTION 2. Section 150A-2, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
11	amended by adding two new definitions to be appropriately
12	inserted and to read as follows:
13	"Cement bulk freight" means unpackaged, homogenous cement,
14	without mark or count and usually free-flowing, bought and sold
15	by weight or volume.
16	"Liquid bulk freight" means unpackaged, homogenous liquid
17	goods, without mark or count and usually free-flowing, bought
18	and sold by weight or volume, such as oil."
19	SECTION 3. Section 150A-5.3, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
20	amended to read as follows:
21	"§150A-5.3 Inspection, quarantine, and eradication service
22	fee and charge. There is imposed a fee for the inspection,

- 1 quarantine, and eradication of invasive species contained in any
- 2 freight, including but not limited to marine commercial
- 3 container shipment, air freight, or any other means of
- 4 transporting freight, foreign or domestic, that is brought into
- 5 the [State.] state, except for liquid bulk freight and cement
- 6 bulk freight. The fee shall be paid by the person responsible
- 7 for paying the freight charges to the transportation company,
- 8 who shall collect the fee and forward the payment to the
- 9 department at the port of disembarkation; provided that the
- 10 transportation company shall not be liable for any fee that is
- 11 not paid by the person responsible for paying the freight
- 12 charges to the transportation company. The department shall
- 13 deposit the fee into the pest inspection, quarantine, and
- 14 eradication fund under section 150A-4.5.
- 15 The fee shall be assessed on the net weight of the imported
- 16 freight computed on the basis of 50 cents for every one thousand
- 17 pounds of freight brought into the [State,] state, or part
- 18 thereof."
- 19 SECTION 4. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 20 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 21 SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
