A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CRUELTY TO ANIMALS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to recognize that		
2	chaining, tethering, or otherwise tying an animal to a		
3	stationary object under certain conditions is inhumane by		
4	establishing certain types of animal restraint as an offense of		
5	cruelty to animals in the second degree.		
6	SECTION 2. Section 711-1109, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is		
7	amended by amending subsection (1) to read as follows:		
8	"(1) A person commits the offense of cruelty to animals in		
9	the second degree if the person intentionally, knowingly, or		
10	recklessly:		
11	(a) Overdrives, overloads, tortures, torments, beats,		
12	causes substantial bodily injury, or starves any		
13	animal, or causes the overdriving, overloading,		
14	torture, torment, beating, or starving of any animal,		
15	or deprives a pet animal of necessary sustenance or		
16	causes such deprivation;		
17	(b) Mutilates, poisons, or kills without need any animal		

(b) Mutilates, poisons, or kills without need any animal other than insects, vermin, or other pests;

1	(C)	Keeps, uses, or in any way is connected with or
2		interested in the management of, or receives money for

13		food; or possess, imports into, or exports from, the
14		state, sells, buys, gives away, or accepts any carcass
15		of any pet or companion animal with the intent to use
16		any part of it or have any other person use any part
17		of it as food. This paragraph shall not be construed
18		to interfere with any agricultural commodity produced
19		in Hawaii or the lawful killing of game mammals with a
20		valid license under section 183D-21.
