## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE HUMANE TREATMENT OF PET ANIMALS.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

| 8  | for more than four hours, except to:                            |
| 9  | (a) Restrain the animal for emergency purposes;                 |
| 10 | (b) Prevent a threat to public safety;                          |
| 11 | (c) Transport the animal to and from a veterinarian             |
| 12 | licensed under chapter 471; or                                  |
| 13 | (d) Allow the animal to participate in a show or exhibit        |
| 14 | operated by a bona fide, duly organized kennel club,            |
| 15 | breed club, or similar organization.                            |
| 16 | It shall be an affirmative defense that the pet animal's        |

17 confinement was beneficial to the animal.
