A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO MEDICAL TORTS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act, to be known as "The
 Hawaii Non-Economic Cap Act of 2009", is to address medical
 malpractice insurance and defensive medical costs by placing a
 \$1,000,000 ceiling on non-economic damages for doctors who
 specialize in the practice of neurology or neurosurgery.

6 This Act is one of eight proposals introduced during the
7 regular session of 2009 designed to address the increasingly
8 problematic medical environment in Hawaii. Collectively, these
9 eight measures shall be known as "the Hawaii doctor recruitment
10 and retention action plan of 2009".

SECTION 2. Chapter 671, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended by adding a new section to part I to be appropriately designated and to read as follows:

14 "<u>§671- Noneconomic damages; ceiling. Damages</u> 15 recoverable for noneconomic damages, as defined in section 66316 8.5, against a licensee under chapter 453 who is board-certified 17 in neurology or neurosurgery shall be limited to a maximum award

18 of \$1,000,000."
