RELATING TO FINANCIAL DISCLOSURE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. The legislature finds that public disclosure of
 incomes of elected officials enhances public trust because the
 disclosure tends to reduce real and perceived conflicts of
 interest.

5 The purpose of this Act is to require legislators to 6 disclose any source of annual income derived from a single 7 source \$25,000 or more, or that represents twenty-five per cent 8 or more of their total annual income received from all sources 9 other than their legislative salaries, if that source may have 10 an interest in the outcome of legislation.

SECTION 2. Chapter 84, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated and to read as follows:

14 "<u>§84-</u> Additional requirements of disclosure; legislator. 15 Notwithstanding any other law to the contrary, and in addition 16 to requirements for disclosure for legislators pursuant to 17 section 84-17, a legislator shall disclose every source of
