BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 467-7, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended to read as follows:
- 3 "\$467-7 Licenses required to act as real estate broker and
- 4 salesperson. No person within the purview of this chapter shall
- 5 act, assume to act, or advertise as a real estate broker or real
- 6 estate salesperson[, or shall advertise, or assume to act as
- 7 real estate broker or real estate salesperson without a license
- 8 previously obtained under and in compliance with this chapter
- 9 and the rules [and regulations] of the real estate
- 10 commission[-]; provided that any licensed real estate broker or
- 11 real estate salesperson in good standing under this chapter and
- 12 applicable real estate commission rules shall not be deemed to
- 13 be engaged in the practice of law when providing services for
- 14 which a license is required under this chapter."
- 15 SECTION 2. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
- 16 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
- 17 begun, before its effective date.
