- 9 A. North shore, Oahu
- 10 Plans, design, equipment, and construction of street
- 11 lights from Crawford Home to the entrance of the
- 12 Turtle Bay Resort.
- 13 Total funding \$ 750,000
- 14 2. To be expended by the department of education:
- 15 A. Waialua high and intermediate school, Oahu
- 16 Plans, design, equipment, and construction for
- 17 renovations and upgrades to the science, technology,



1	engineering, and mathematics learning center as
2	support for the robotics program.
3	Total funding \$ 750,000
4	SECTION 3. The sums appropriated for the respective
5	capital projects set forth in section 2 shall be expended by the
6	designated expending agency for the purposes of this Act.
