A BILL FOR AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR THE AMERICAN RED CROSS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the American Red
2	Cross is a humanitarian organization that is tax-exempt under
3	Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code and chartered by
4	the United States Congress. The mission of the American Red
5	Cross is to prevent and alleviate human suffering by providing
6	relief to victims of disasters and helping to prevent, prepare
7	for, and respond to emergencies. In this mission, the American
8	Red Cross, Hawaii Chapter, works hand-in-hand with the state
9	department of defense, civil defense agency.
10	Hawaii is especially vulnerable to hurricanes, tsunami, and
11	other natural disasters. As the gateway to Asia and the
12	Pacific, Hawaii must be equally cognizant of threats from avian
13	flu, bio-terrorist attacks, and other non-natural disasters. It
14	is not a matter of "if" but of "when" a major disaster will
15	strike Hawaii. Further, due to the geographic isolation of the
16	state, in the event of a major disaster, the residents of Hawaii
17	will have to survive on their own for a longer period of time

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    than in many other states before aid may come from outside the

    state.

         According to a draft Federal Support CONOP for Catastrophic
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    Hurricane Impacting State of Hawaii to be released shortly by
5
    the Federal Emergency Management Agency, a category three or
6
    four storm, the same force as hurricane Iniki, would destroy or
7
    heavily damage thirty-eight per cent of all homes and leave
8
    another forty per cent of the remaining homes with damage.
9
         Presently, the American Red Cross, Hawaii Chapter, provides
10
    aid to the people of Hawaii who fall victim to natural and man-
11
    made disasters that occur about every three days in Hawaii. To
12
    continuously prepare for and meet these challenges, the staff
13
    and volunteers of the American Red Cross, Hawaii Chapter, are on
14
    duty twenty-four hours a day, seven days a week. At the main
15
    headquarters of the Hawaii Chapter in Honolulu, volunteers are
16
    constantly being trained, emergency supplies are continually
    restocked and stored, and equipment and personnel stand by ready
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18
    for any future major disaster. Furthermore, ongoing efforts to
19
    fortify and harden the headquarters to protect staff and
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    volunteers, equipment and supplies, and the provision of
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services in a major disaster continue constantly.

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         The purpose of this Act is to make an appropriation to
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    allow the department of defense, civil defense agency, to assist
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    the American Red Cross, Hawaii Chapter, to harden and fortify
    its Hawaii Chapter headquarters in Honolulu and four neighbor

         SECTION 2. The following sums, or so much thereof as shall

    be necessary to finance the projects listed in this Act, are

    hereby appropriated out of the general revenues of the State of

    Hawaii for fiscal year 2009-2010, as a grant pursuant to chapter
