## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO REAL PROPERTY.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Due to the economic emergency affecting the 2 State of Hawaii, there shall be a temporary moratorium on all 3 commercial, retail, and industrial lease rent increases, 4 including annual or periodic rent step-ups already negotiated, 5 for the period commencing on , and ending on December 31, 2010. The term "rent" shall not include additions to rent such 6 7 as pro-rata maintenance fees, pro-rata operating expenses, real 8 property taxes, utilities, chill water charges, Hawaii general 9 excise tax, and any other expense that would constitute a 10 reimbursement of costs to the lessor. This moratorium does not 11 affect the lessor's right to terminate the lease or to pursue 12 summary possession or collection of a debt arising from a 13 lessee's default for non-payment of rent and charges payable under this moratorium, nor does it affect a lessor's rights and 14 15 remedies under the lease for breach of a non-monetary default, 16 all such rights and remedies are not affected by this 17 legislation.
